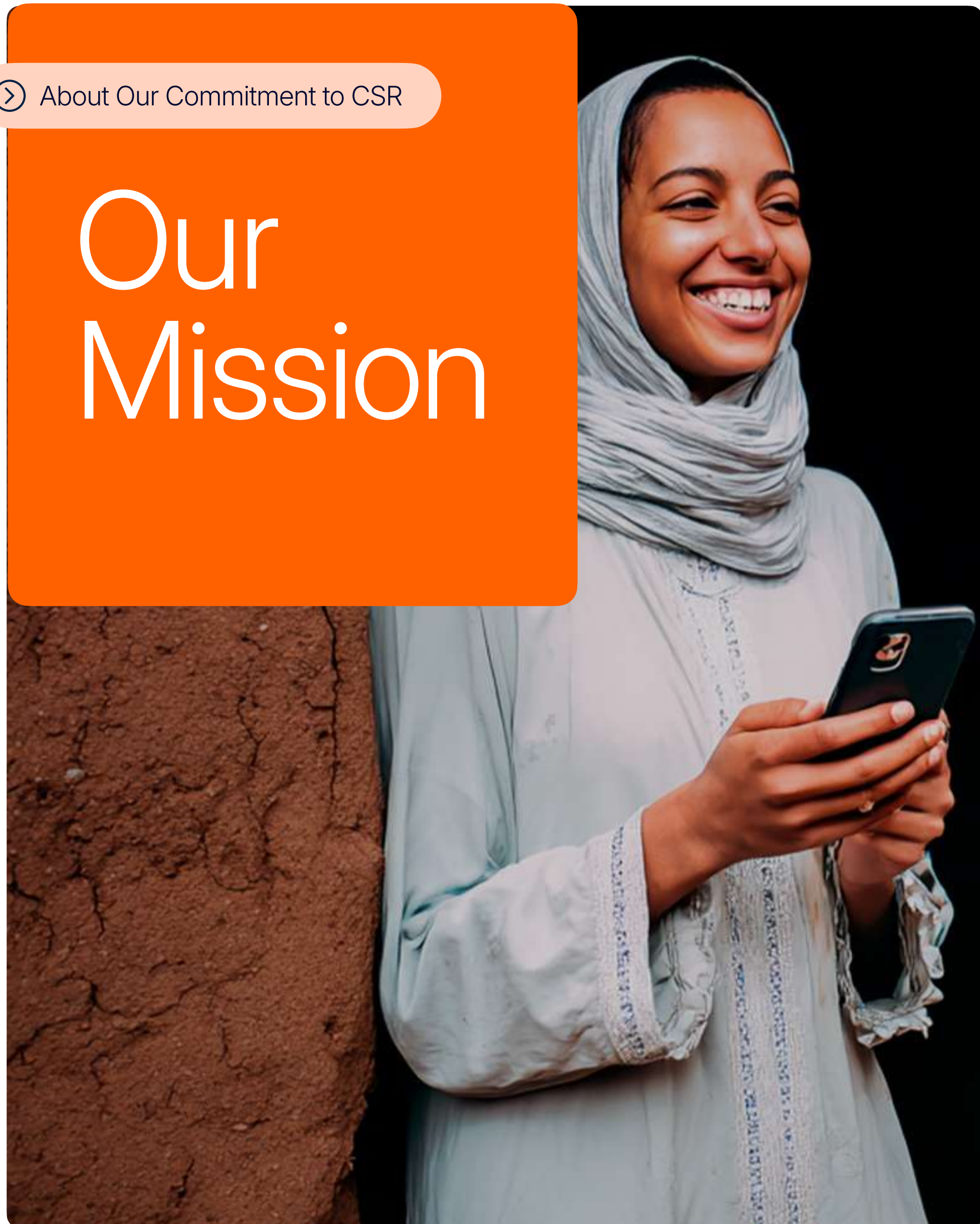

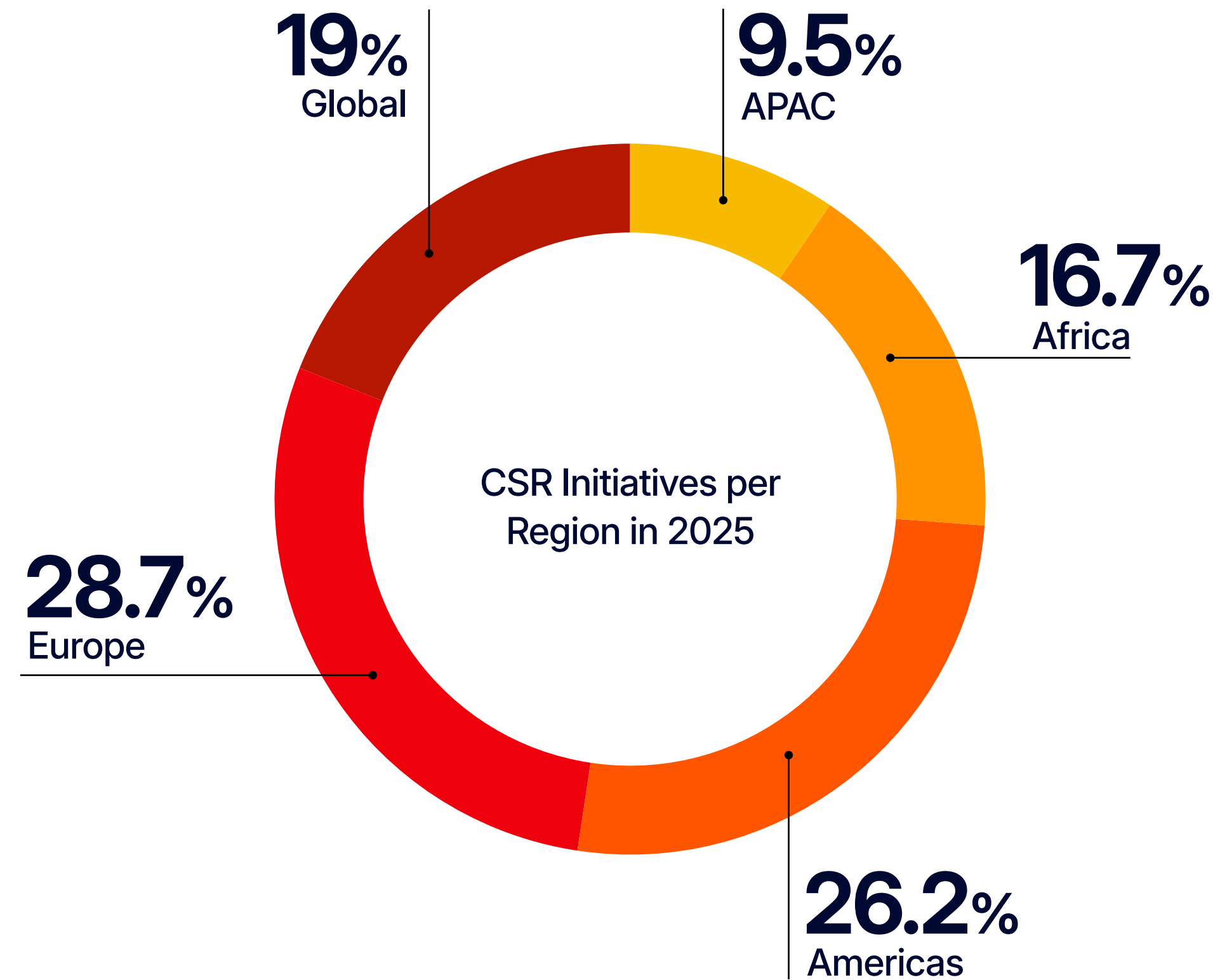
Regional Coverage

We covered **100%** of the regions where Ria is present, with a majority of our offices actively taking part in CSR activities.

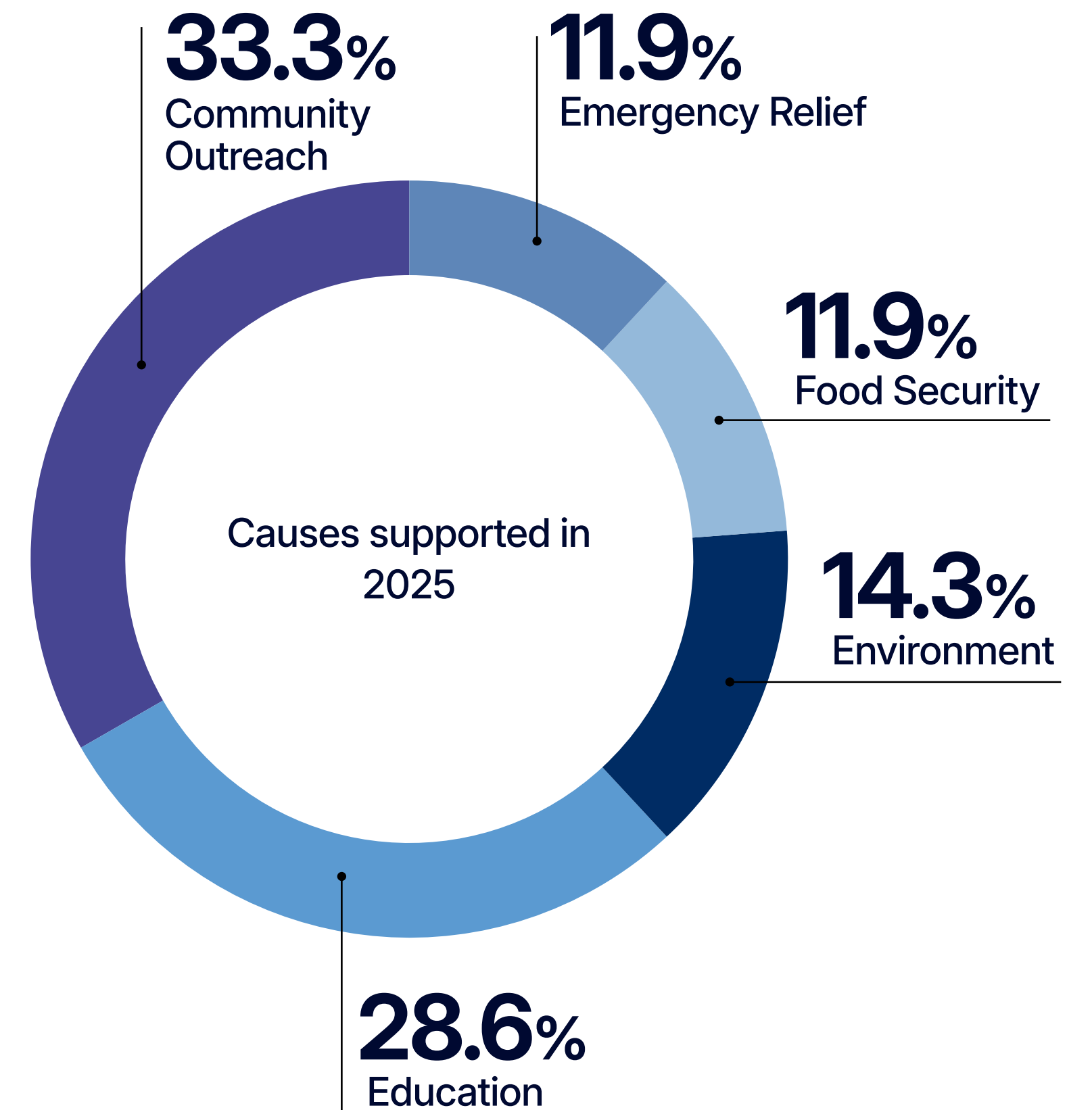
On-the-Ground Involvement

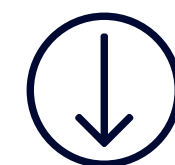

Quality Learning for All

This project helps improve access to quality education for children with disabilities in preschool and primary school. It directly addresses the lack of adequate infrastructures, training, and resources needed to support different learning needs in the classrooms.

By equipping teachers with the right tools and strategies, we helped schools become more inclusive, giving more children the opportunity to learn, participate, and thrive alongside their peers.

Philippines

Resilient Outcomes Through Opportunities for Transformative Solutions (ROOTS) By Children

The project is directed at children, including Indigenous children and children with disabilities, in Antipolo City, Philippines. It is designed to help them exercise their right to be heard in decisions that affect their safety and wellbeing.

In a community regularly impacted by flooding and extreme weather, the project helped children work with local leaders to improve disaster and climate planning, addressing real risks such as access to school during emergencies.

Save The Children

The Good Teacher documentary was created to shine a light on educators' invaluable work, and its success speaks volumes: with 400,000+ views across platforms and three Cannes Corporate awards, the film has resonated across borders.

The Good Teacher Documentary

The video honors the incredible work of Mexican teachers who are actively fighting to improve access to education in their country through community-made Early Childhood Education Centers.


It was shot in late 2024, when a Ria team travelled to Mexico to visit the centers that we help through our partnership with Save the Children. While there, the team had the chance to meet the educators who run them.

The documentary gives a voice to these teachers directly, offering a rare, intimate look into the challenges and triumphs of teaching in under-resourced areas. Above all, the documentary reminds us of the profound impact that a single teacher can have. It also shines a light on the importance of Save the Children's work, as the protagonists explain how programs like these help them continue doing their work.

Teletón USA & El Salvador



We have partnered with the Teletón Foundation for 13 years. Through this collaboration, we are able to support Teletón’s mission of providing rehabilitation services for children with disabilities to improve their wellbeing and daily lives. The physical, social, and psychological support benefits not only the children themselves but their families as well.

Fundraising Efforts

In 2025, we went the extra mile. Ria employees met and bonded with Teletón beneficiaries, getting to know their inspiring stories. Others shared personal testimonies, explaining why this cause was dear to their heart. It was a reminder of the powerful impact that a little help can have.

We raised funds for both Funter Teletón El Salvador and the TeletónUSA Foundation through in-store and phone-based donation campaigns at participating Ria locations. Thanks to our efforts and the generosity of our customers, we were able to raise enough funds to provide over 3,000 therapies for children with disabilities. We also contributed with a corporate donation of \$35,000 to maximize our impact.

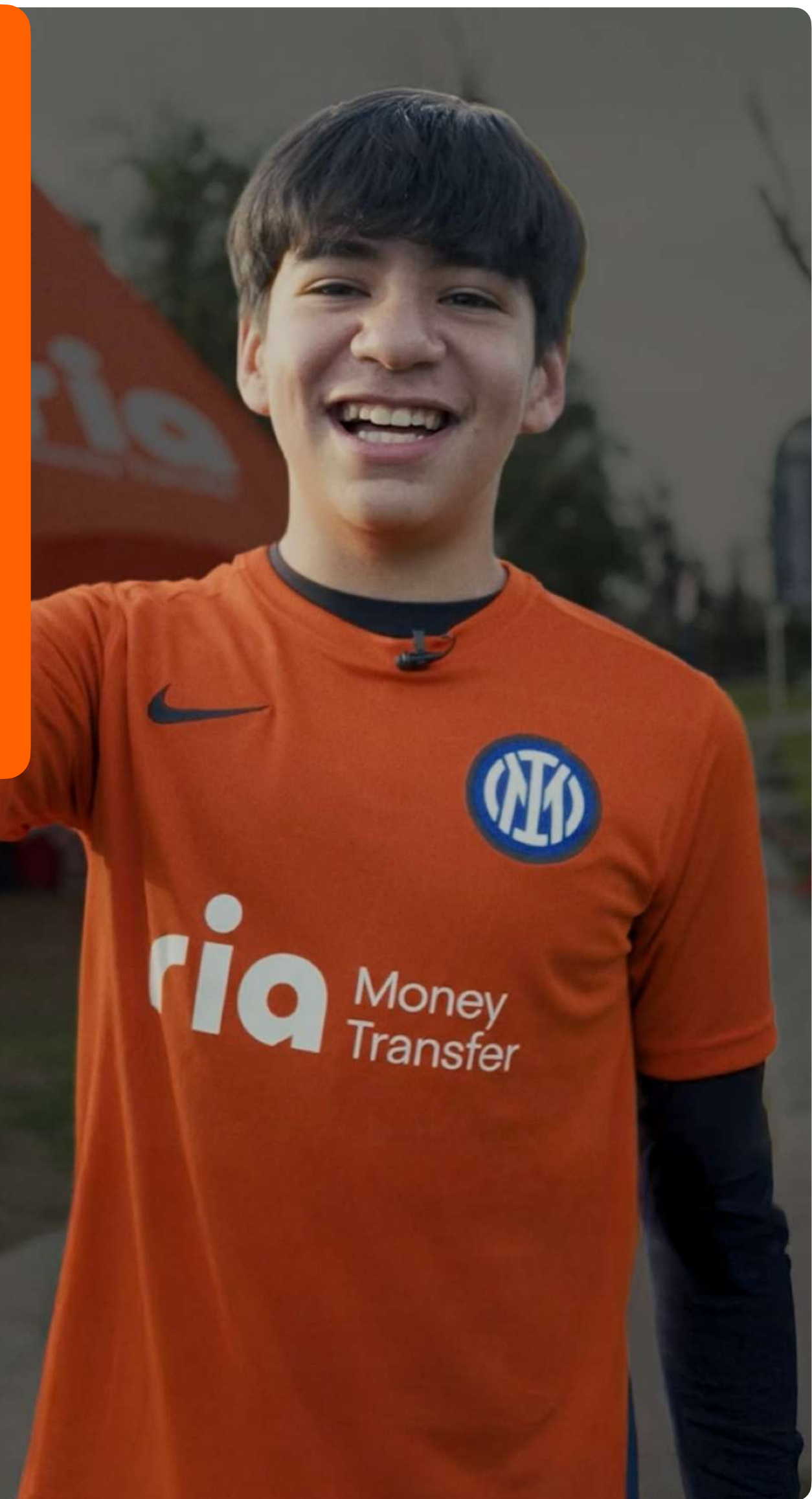


In December 2025, Sri Lanka was hit by devastating floods after cyclone Ditwah hit the country. The Shanu Foundation immediately responded by providing emergency relief to the locals, and we donated to support its vital efforts. Our collaboration helped deliver kits to hundreds of households including essentials like bed sheets, nets, towels, soap, diapers, mats, food, among other items of use for Sri Lankan families and children in this time of need.

Together, we already built a **Dreamers School** in **Mannar**, Sri Lanka, back in 2023. Located in a rural area of the country, the school improved access to education for local children, all while creating several construction and teaching jobs. The project was so successful that we have started building a second **Dreamers School** in **Batticaloa**, Sri Lanka.

This year, we launched the first **Dreamers United Sports Academy** in Sri Lanka. This new project is the fruit of our joint commitment to empower youth through sports and creating spaces where children can thrive.

Inter Academy



We have been the official money transfer partners of Football Club Internazionale Milano (Inter) for over two years now. But this fruitful partnership goes beyond the pitch, taking its roots in our shared values.



Sponsoring Inter Academy Chile Players

Like Ria, Inter is a long-time champion of education. To empower children, they have opened Inter Academies all around the world. These dedicated spaces enable young players to train, learn, and evolve in a nurturing environment. Since 2024, we've been sponsoring **Inter Academy Chile** players by providing children with **scholarships** that allow them to access this unique space. Thanks to this school, boys and girls have a safe space to grow and develop physical and emotional skills while under the professional guidance of Inter's trainers.



Unlocking New Opportunities for Inter Academy Players

This year, we sponsored four Inter Academy players so they could travel from Chile to Italy to train with world-class coaches and attend a match at the famous San Siro Stadium. Through initiatives like this one, we help children access meaningful learning experiences that are beneficial to their development, while opening their horizons and show them they can dream big.

Proyecto Migrante

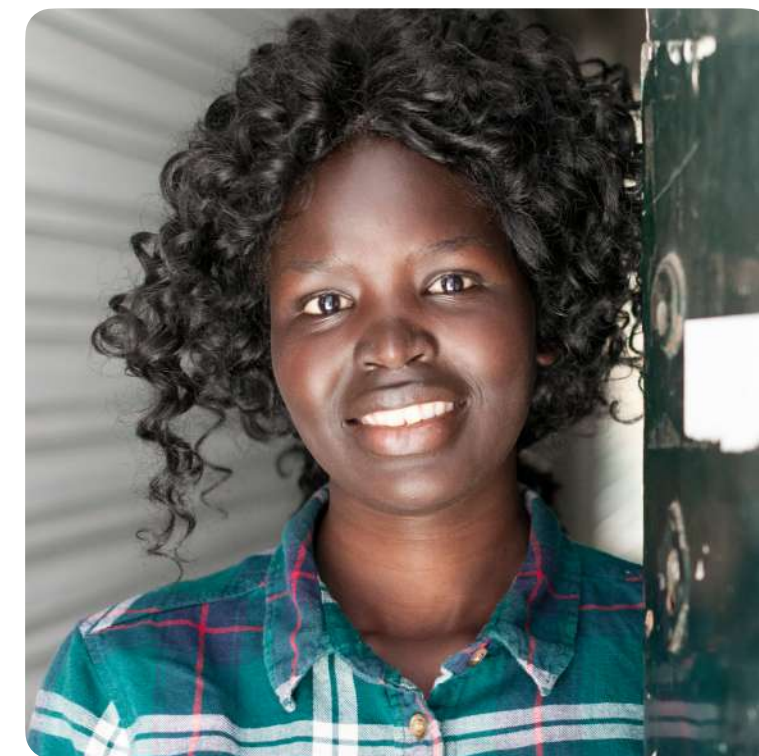


This year, we partnered with Proyecto Migrante, a collaborative community whose goal is to help migrants integrate into their new home.

Their project is extremely significant to us, as it reflects our deep respect for the resilience and determination of migrant communities who are striving to build better futures, not just for themselves but for their loved ones back home. Our crucial support allows Proyecto Migrante to continue carrying out their mission and expand their reach.



With our support, they have provided much-needed meals, essential personal hygiene services, were able to take their first international steps, travelling to the Philippines and Peru to give back to the communities connected to the migrants they serve in Spain.



They brought food, smiles, and hope to children and families in remote rural communities. We look forward to continuing to contribute to their meaningful work in the future.

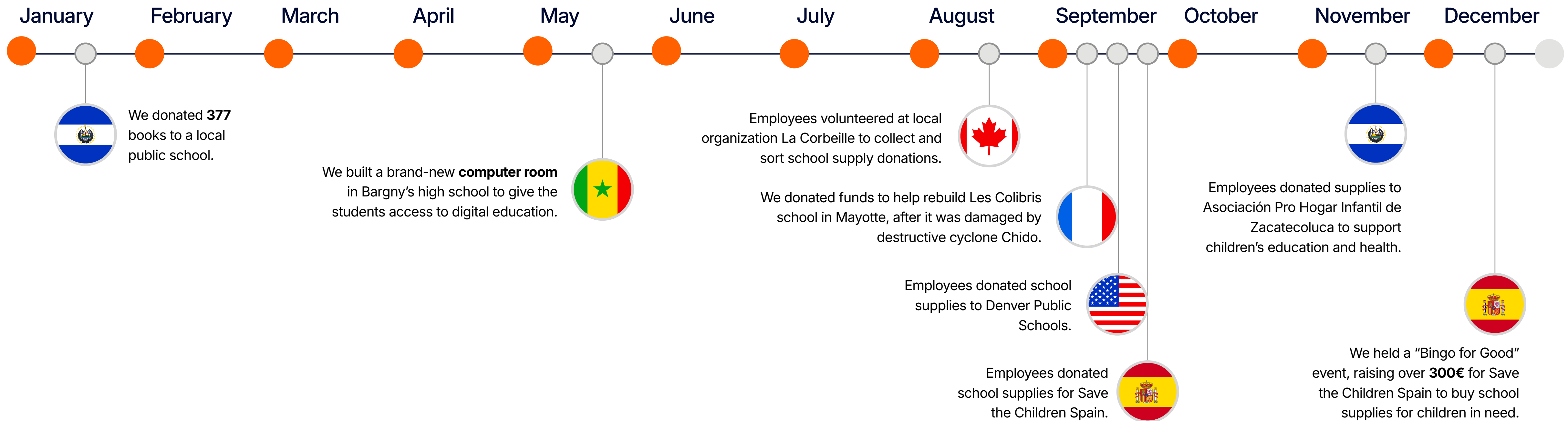
Throughout the year, our employees and local offices took the lead in bringing our values to life through local initiatives.

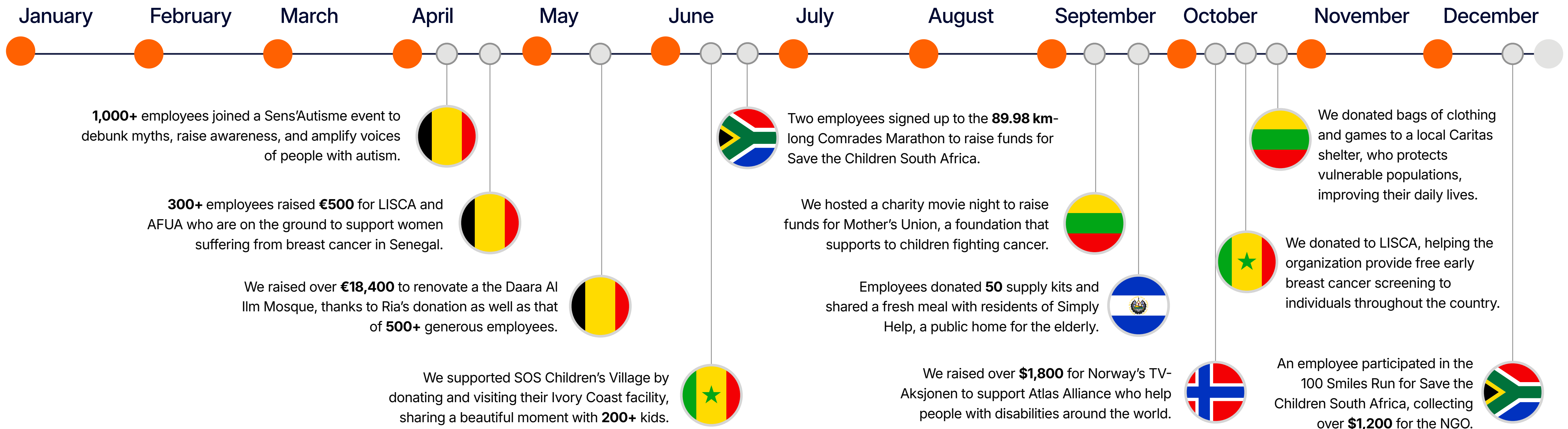

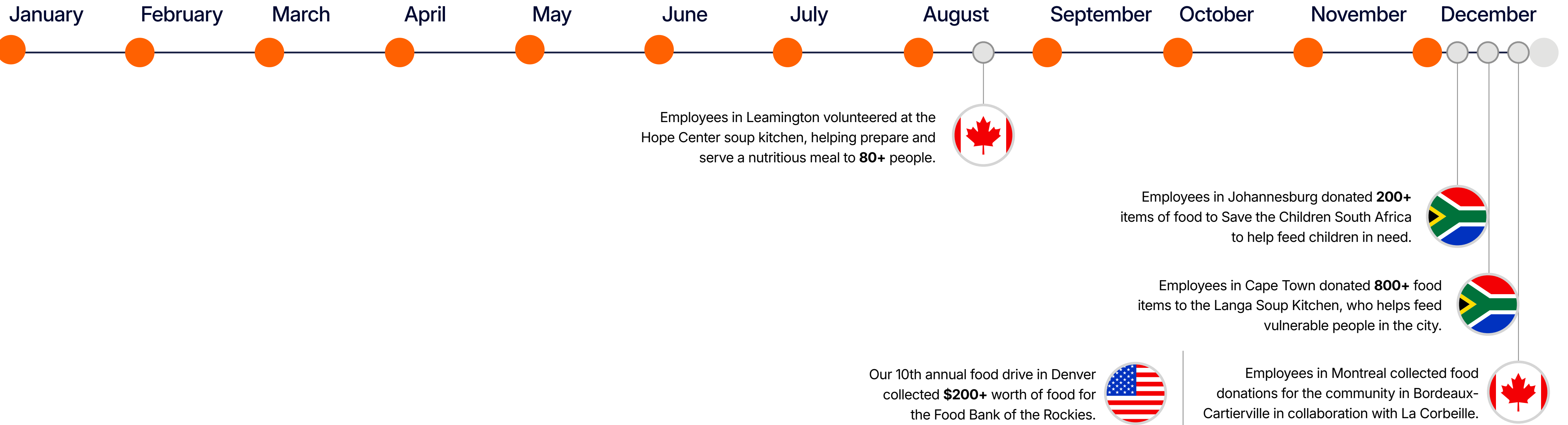

Access to nutritious food is essential to wellbeing. That is why our offices supported initiatives that helped address food insecurity and provide meals to individuals in need.

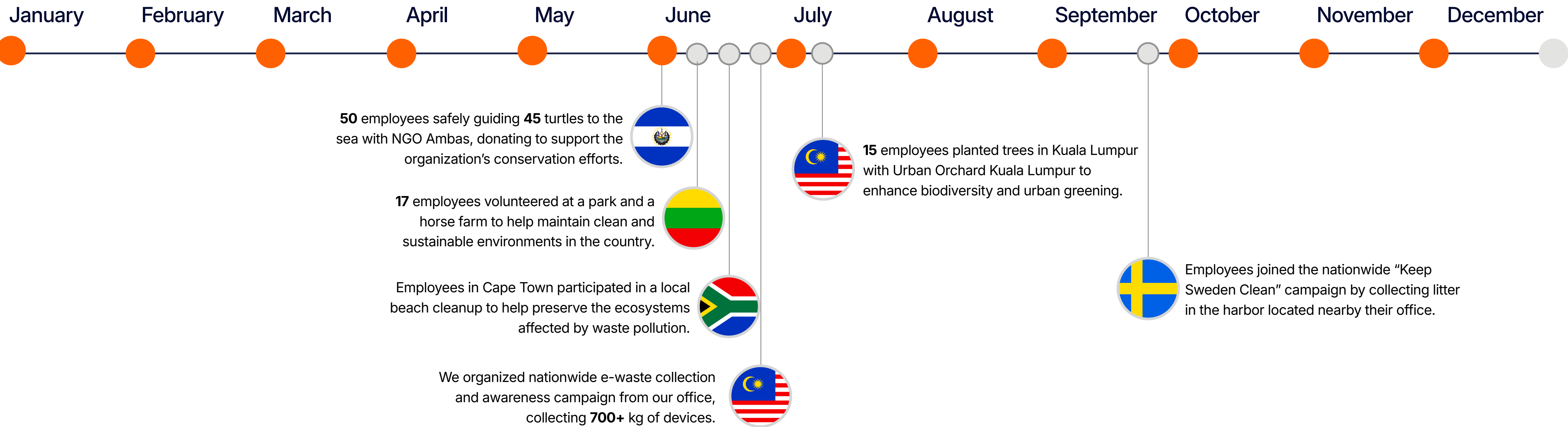

This year's impact reflects our purpose: to help people support their loved ones across borders and while also playing an active role in the communities we serve.

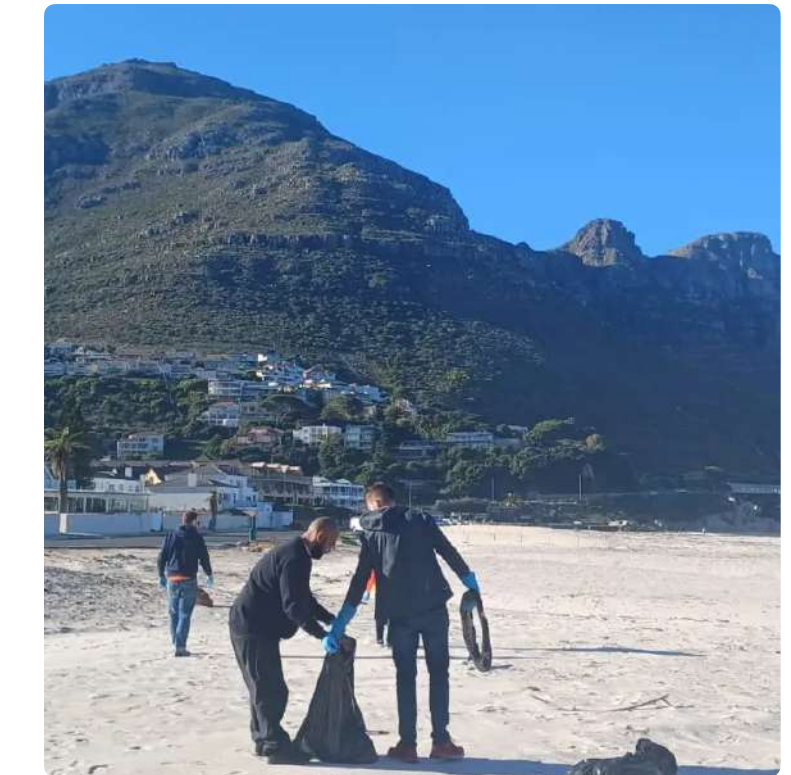
